Laying the Foundation for the Next 50 Years at Temple Kol Ami





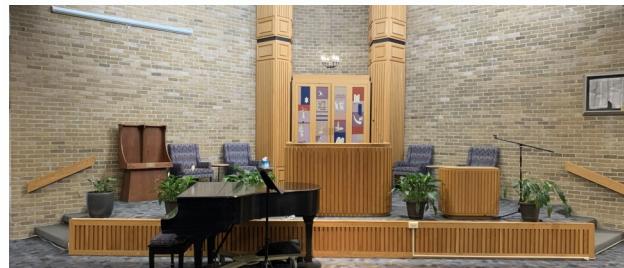
Rabbi Natalie Shribman
